

Vendor Requirements Rassawek Spring Jubilee

June 3rd & 4th, 2023 at Rassawek Vineyard, Columbia, VA

Application Process

- All vendors must apply each year, including vendors who have participated in previous festivals. Applications are due April 28th, 2023.
- Applicants must submit with application a minimum of two (2) color photos of your booth set-up looks like and what you are demonstrating or selling; these will not be returned.
- Completed and signed applications, including the vendor fee
- The Rassawek Spring Jubilee Committee will review the applications and notify you if your application was accepted or not accepted. Once accepted the vendor fee will be processed.
 Vendors must carry business general liability insurance for their protection. The COI should list Rassawek Spring Jubilee June 3 & 4, 2023 at Rassawek Vineyards 6276 Riv Read West Columbia VA 23038. Please list additional
- Ticket Information: Vendors and their staff are given 4 wrist bands for the general addmission entry for the whole weekend. These will be given to you at the time of set-up. If you have more staff, please purchase general addmission tickets in advance at rassawek.com.We do not offer a vendor will call at the front gate.
- Each vendor will receive event day kit with parking information through email, and event details the week of May 24th, 2023.
- Failure to meet vendor fee deadlines may result in forfeiture of booth space.

Vendor Fee

VENDOR: \$200.00; 10' x 10' space \$400.00; 10' x 20' space

• **FOOD VENDOR**: \$200.00; 10' x 10' space \$300.00; 10'x 15' space & \$400.00; 10'x15' space

 Cancellation policy: 75% of fee will be refunded if notification is received more than 30 days from event date.
 Cancellations within 30 days of event will forfeit 100% of the vendor fee.

Sunday 11am - 5pm

Friday: June 2nd: 9am-7pm

Saturday: June 3rd: 6am-9am

Sunday: June 4th: 8am-10am

Vendors must be set up and be operational to the public according to times listed on application.

Application Requirements

- All handcrafted items that are for sale must be created by the artist/vendor. This is a show for artists and craftsmen and not a show for commercialism or dealers. RSJ strongly encourages vendors to perform ongoing demonstrations during the Spring Jubilee.
- If approved for participation and acceptance, RSJ has the right to promote your involvement as necessary but without guarantee.
- Images and artwork submitted in the application maybe used on our website to promote your exhibit. All images will be associated with name of artist or exhibitor.
- Vendors must carry business general liability insurance for their protection. The COI should list Rassawek Spring Jubilee June 3 & 4, 2023 at Rassawek Vineyards 6276 River Road West Columbia VA 23038. Please list additional insured: Joseph E. Liesfeld Jr., JEL Columbia Farm, LLC., Rassawek Vineyards LLC, Rassawek Ventures Inc, and Rassawek Farm LLC.
- Food vendors are required to have a temporary food establishment application and permit on file for RSJ with Goochland County Health Department. If you have questions regarding the health department's requirements, please contact Jeanelle Rogers at 804-556-5843. Download the Temporary food establishment application online.
- Compliance with all local Health Department and Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (VDACS) regulations is the responsibility of the vendor.
- Vendors wishing to sell cheese and other dairy products, meats and baked goods must comply with VDACS regulations. Contact the VDACS Food Safety Program at 804.786.3501 for assistance.
- Vendors are responsible for state and federal taxes. For assistance, check out the Virginia Department of Taxation website:www.tax.virginia.gov
- Vendors may not trade or switch spaces, or set up in any other location.
- The layout of the Spring Jubilee is subject to change year to year depending on site conditions.
- Drinking alcoholic beverages in your booth is prohibited.
- All fixtures and materials are left overnight are at the vendors' risk. The Festival's insurance will not cover personal property, so vendors should obtain their own insurance.
- For the safety of the festival's attendees, <u>all personal</u> vehicles are NOT ALLOWED to move onto or within the site during the hours of 9am-6:30pm on Saturday and 10am-5:30pm on Sunday.
- Vendor Parking: MORNING Shuttles/golf carts will be running for vendors from 6:00am-9:30am (SAT) & 9:00am-10:30am (SUN).
 EVENINGS Shuttles/golf carts will be running for vendors from 6:30pm-7:00pm (SAT) & 5:30pm-6:00pam (SUN).
